CEP Example

The State Dept of Education, Office of Child Nutrition has received and approved your SFA's application for participation in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). Below is an analysis of the data provided by your district:

A school district can determine the percent of Identified Students (ISP) by individual schools, a group of schools within the district, or as an aggregate for all schools if all schools in the district are participating. Please note that not all schools in the group or in the LEA if electing for the entire LEA have to meet the 40% threshold as long as the group as a whole has an ISP of 40% or higher. This allows for some schools to be below the 40% threshold as long as the aggregate of the group of schools meets the threshold. <name of district> may participate in the CEP using the aggregate for the district, 100% of all breakfast and lunch meals claimed will be reimbursed at the federal free rate. There will be no meals reimbursed at the reduced rate.

The district must determine whether they can operate the program given the expected level of Federal reimbursement and other non-Federal funds available to them. Please note that, similar to Provision 2 and
