# E-Rate Board Resolution



- Vote to approve or disapprove Resolution for Schools and Libraries Universal Services (E-Rate) for 2021-22.
- This resolution authorizes filing of the Form 471 applications for funding year 2021-22 and the payment of the applicant's share upon approval of funding and receipt of services.

## RESOLUTION

Be it resolved that the governing board for YOUR SCHOOL DISTRICT

1. Authorizes the filing of FCC Form 471, Schools and Libraries Universal Service Program Services Ordered and Certification Form for the services and/or products as detailed in the attached report, "E-Rate Requests, FY 2019", for the fiscal year 07/01/2019-06/30/2020.
2. Authorizes payment of the applicant's share subject to the following conditions:
  - (1) approval of funding of the discounted portion by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) and
  - (2) receipt of services during the fiscal year 07/01/2019-06/30/2020.

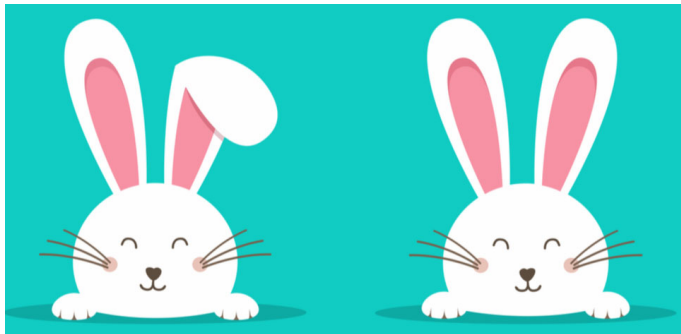
